CHAMPAGNES

Piper-Heidsieck is a Champagne house founded by Florens-Louis Heidsieck on July 16, 1785 in Reims. Heidsieck joined with Piper in October 1839.

Piper-Heidsieck Essentiel Brut

glass 10,00

Its four years of maturation give the Essentiel

bottle 60,00

a no-nonsense charm. This is a clear, intense wine with pure notes of citrus, grapes, apple and almond. The hints of nuts and refined sweetness are an indication of the long rest period this wine has enjoyed.

50-55% Pinot Noir - 30-35% Meunier - 15-20% Chardonnay

Piper-Heidsieck Cuvée Sublime

bottle 70,00

Cuvée Sublime sensually displays its romantic charms and enchants you while the scents of vanilla, rum, tropical fruit and roasted pineapple slowly let go.

50-55% Pinot Noir - 30-35% Meunier - 15-20% Chardonnay

Piper-Heidsieck Rosé Sauvage

bottle 80,00

Chardonnays of the Montagne de Reims come together with Pinot Noirs of Les Riceys in the Côte des Bar, the most southern Champagne vineyard. The result is a very intense Champagne with hints of juicy berries with spicy and smoky notes. This Champagne is ideal to be served with duck and other red meat dishes.

50-55% Pinot Noir out of which 20-25% vinified as red wines - 30-35% Meunier - 15-20% Chardonnay

Piper-Heidsieck Rare Millésime 1999

bottle 250,00

Rare Millésime 1999 carries an eccentricity bred by extreme weather conditions. Its taste caresses the palate, revealing fleshy notes of herbal tea, mirabelle plum, bergamot and spices with a persistent aftertaste of candied fruit.

70% Chardonnay - 30% Pinot Noir

Piper-Heidsieck Rare Millésime 1988

bottle 500,00

Because of the intense year 1988 was, Rare Millésime 1988 is a generous and intoxicating wine. Its "conviviality" requires the wine to be tasted like a great cognac. Given its seductive, welcoming refinement, it offers incredible ageing potential. Powerful notes of hazelnuts and dried berries are combined with the delicious scents of sandalwood and incense.

Taittinger Les Folies de la Marquetterie

The House's very first single-vineyard Champagne.

Les Folies de la Marquetterie is made exclusively from grapes grown at the Folies vineyard that overlooks the Château de la Marquetterie, the birthplace of the Taittinger family.

45% Chardonnay – 55% Pinot Noir

Taittinger Comtes de Champagne Blanc de Blancs

bottle 190,00

Produced in the cellars of the former Saint-Nicaise abbey (13th century) in Reims, this champagne receives all the lavish care and attention it needs to reach its peak. Every bottle strictly adheres to all necessary requirements to make it such a rare luxury and the connoisseurs choice.

WHITE WINES

Obikwa Chenin Blanc

South Africa

bottle 27,00

This grand grape from the Loire is frequently cultivated on South-African vineyards. Drinks away effortlessly; vivid, fruity and refreshing. Enjoy it as an apéritif or with shrimp croquettes, mussels or poultry.

Les hautes de JANEIL

France

bottle 28,00

A fine Pays d'Oc wine, composed of Grenache and Sauvignon grapes. With a scent of hazel, citrus and peppery spices. With a rich and solid finish.

Don Cristobal - Verdelho

Mendoza - Argentina

bottle 31,00

A surprising wine from one of the best wine regions in Argentina. Very intense, fruity bouquet of white flowers with a fresh taste of ripe apple, pineapple, citrus and melon, with a fine acidity.

Gruber Röschitz Pepp Grüner Veltliner

Weinviertel – Austria

bottle 33,00

Gruber Röschitz is three generations, three siblings, three straight bull's-eyes! The nose carries a lot of fruits and herbs. On the palate there's green apple, citrus and white pepper. A beautiful, young, lively wine that is very playful and crispy.

Dal Cero Pinot Grigio

Veneto - Italy

bottle 35,00

A very plump nose of ripe pineapple. This Pinot Grigio combines a warm exotic character with fresh citrus notes. Highly recommended!

Gruber Röschitz Pepp Riesling**Weinviertel - Austria****bottle 37,00**

Gruber Röschitz is three generations, three siblings, three straight bull's-eyes! The Riesling ... how stunning its aromas are. Juicy flavors of apricot and peach with a very pleasant balance of acidity.

1884 Reservado - Viognier**Mendoza - Argentina****bottle 41,00**

This wine has the structure of a Chardonnay, but with its own appearance and distinctive aromas such as dried apricots, peach, mango, nuts and honey. This delicious Viognier is very tasty with all kinds of salads, seafood and spicy and Mediterranean fish dishes.

Luis Felipe Edwards - Chardonnay reserva**Chile****bottle 38,00**

This famous wine family only produces top wines. This Chardonnay grape ripens slowly because of the cool sea climate which lends it a nice freshness and then partly matures on in oak barrels. A super Chardonnay!

Sauvignon Blanc Cellar Selection, Villa Maria BIO**New Zealand****bottle 41,00**

A strong, juicy and utterly pure expression of the Sauvignon Blanc from Marlborough, cultivated by a wine producer that, over the last 30 years, has won the most medals of all. A wine with a bouquet of passion fruit, lemon and gooseberry.

Tastes great with a fish tartare and vegetable or grilled fish wok.

Les Chanteaux Chinon Blanc**Loire - France****bottle 48,00**

This is a varietal white wine made from the Chenin grape, originating from a south-facing plot where the vines are on average fifteen years old. This wine has floral and mineral notes with fresh citrus aromas. Delicious with fish dishes, risotto and green asparagus.

Hannes Reeh Rohstoff Chardonnay

Burgenland - Austria

bottle 51,00

'Rohstoff' = Hannes Reeh's top wines! Coming from one specific vineyard, they are an expression of purity and authenticity. This 100% Chardonnay was fermented in the tank with 30% getting barrel maturation.

Delicious floral notes, plus aromas of pear and nuts in the nose.

A nice soft and round taste in the mouth. To say this fantastic Chardonnay has elegance, structure and balance would be an understatement.

ROSÉ WINES

Decanto Bardolino DOC Rosé

Italy

bottle 28,00

A beautiful dry rosé from the north of Italy. With a floral bouquet, a velvety taste and a pleasant aftertaste. Perfect as an aperitif but also delicious with pasta and fish dishes.

Ceci n'est pas un rosé Scaramouche

Ivo Varbanov Wijnerij, Bulgaria

bottle 45,00

This wine contains 67% Marselan and 33% Syrah grapes and has aged for 18 months in 500-liter Bulgarian oak barrels. This exciting and unusual wine is especially appreciated as a wine to accompany your meal and not as much as an aperitif. René Magritte "Ceci n'est pas une pipe". (1928-29)

RED WINES

Obikwa Pinotage

South-Africa

bottle 27,00

A red wine, made from the typical South-African grape Pinotage, that already has won several prizes (s.a. Decanter, International Wine Challenge ...). A tender and fruity wine that goes well with all kinds of red and white meat, both grilled and roasted.

Irreverente – Udaca

Dão - Portugal

bottle 28,00

Lush ripe plums, red berries, cherries in the nose with a slight spiciness. The taste is rather complex and full, but with sufficient finesse - just enough to leave this wine out of the 'powerful wines' category. Beautifully balanced.

Ai Galera Poetico

Tejo – Portugal

glass 6,00 bottle 32,00

This blend of indigenous Portuguese grapes (Castelão, Trincadeira and Tinta Miuda) comes from the Tejo region, just outside Lisbon. It's a deep ruby red wine with a very pleasant nose of red and black berries. Purely fruit-driven, this wine has a nice balance between acidity and the soft tannins.

Château Sainte-Eulalie 'Plaisir d'Eulalie'

Languedoc-Roussillon - France

bottle 29,00

The unique location of the vineyards and the age of the Grenache, Syrah and Carignan vines result in a very typically southern wine with beautifully structured tannins. A delicious wine with cheese, venison, pasta and grilled dishes.

Sant Josep Clot Negre

Terra Alta – Spain

bottle 31,00

This blend of Grenache, Syrah and Carignan has a beautiful dark red, even light purple color. Full body with a soft aftertaste. Intense, fruity flavors with Mediterranean influences.

G rard Bertrand "Prima Nature" Cabernet-Sauvignon

Languedoc - France

bottle 33,00

This Cabernet-Sauvignon has an intense red color with aromas of blackberry, blackcurrant and plums. Fantastic with spicy dishes as well as red meat and stew.

Portillo - Malbec

Mendoza - Argentina

bottle 35,00

Supple, full red wine. Nice red fruit with a fruity aftertaste with soft tannins. Winner at the "Argentina Wine Awards 2012".

Ch teau Belle-Garde

Bordeaux - France

bottle 39,00

The 'Ch teau Belle-Garde' is a classic red Bordeaux with sufficient structure and backbone and is also easy to drink. This wine goes perfectly with venison and red meat.

A-Mano Primitivo

Puglia - Italy

bottle 41,00

An amazingly tasteful red wine that is 100% made with 'Primitivo', the same grape as the Zinfandel from California! With a full, fruity side that quickly gets the upper hand, this powerful wine goes great with summer dishes and cold dishes, as well as hearty meat platters and barbecue.

El Chaparral de Vega Sindoa

Navarra - Spanje

bottle 43,00

This 'El Chaparral de Vega Sindoa' is 100% made from the Grenache grape and comes off vines that are between 60 and 110 years old! Its 8 months of maturation in oak barrels make it spicy and fruity with impressions of ripe red fruit, pepper and bay leaf.

Highly recommended with a very exceptional price/quality ratio!

Precision Wines Navigator Cabernet Sauvignon

California - USA

bottle 48,00

Precision Wines represents DNA California with great finesse and respect for tradition. This Cab' has enjoyed an aging process of 50% on new American oak and 50% on neutral oak. This gives you a complex but easy-drinking wine that every wine lover will appreciate very much.

Hints of dark red fruit, mint and coconut. Very soft, but long finish!

Cruz de Alba Tempranillo

Ribera del Duero - Spain

bottle 51,00

This biodynamic wine comes from a domain close to the famous domain of Vega Sicilia and is made from 45-year-old Tempranillo vines and aged in oak barrels for a period of 15 months. It has an intense red color and brings a variety of red and black fruits to mind, with wood notes to boot. Perfect with red meat.

Couvent De l'Eglise

Pomerol - France 2013

bottle 55,00

This Pomerol is made from Merlot and Cabernet Franc. Plummy, mild, and soft in taste. Perfect with gently cooked meat.
